Cattle Update:

April snow last week prevented rancher Awbrey Cyrus from transporting her cattle to the grazing allotment on the Cline Buttes. RECOA has since learned the animals will be released this week.

Ms. Cyrus is sub-leasing from the Thornburghs, who hold the grazing permit. This year the area will be grazed by 30 cow-calf pairs for 30 days. One bull will be in the herd. Water will be provided in the southern part of the range in hopes the cattle will concentrate there. This year the water tank behind the horse corral in Creekside will not be filled.

At this writing RECOA fencing along the border with BLM land appears to be secure. Ms. Cyrus has been a good neighbor and has worked to ensure fencing on the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) property is adequate, and users are responsible for closing and latching gates.

You may see cattle when recreating on BLM land and while they are not aggressive, they can be curious. They are also very large so it's best to give them plenty of space and to keep pets at a safe distance.

If you see cows on RECOA or private property please call Eagle Crest Management right away at 541-548-9310 if it is during regular business hours, and email or phone at least one Board member so we know action is being taken. After hours and on weekends, please contact any Board member by phone or email so we can attempt to contact Ms. Cyrus.

Creekside Bridge Repair:

The footbridges in Creekside and Eagle Creek communities are in the work!

The structural repairs and modifications are complete: the vendor has replaced all posts and rails on each footbridge, has added a set of lower handrails, and has added steps to the Creekside footbridge.

Drier weather is needed before the walking surfaces can be sanded. After sanding, all portions of the footbridges will be stained. Depending on weather conditions, we might see that happen before the end of April.

These efforts are long-awaited. And your patience is much appreciated. Our hope is for the revitalized footbridges to last for the next 4-5 years. To that end, please report any failures, damages, or misuse to Eagle Crest Management as soon as noted, Ownerservices@eagle-crest.com.

Please take care when using the footbridges! And please supervise youngsters who might be unaware of the risks, with water and rocks below!

Spray Notice: Per a new Oregon Law, the Association must provide owners a seven-day notice before spraying occurs. Owners can find the MSDS Sheet on the RECOA website on the left-hand side under "Community Info."

Our Landscaping company is onsite Monday-Friday starting mid-March through December (weather depending). The landscaper spot sprays all the planter beds in the RECOA common area and the managed neighborhoods during their weekly visits. Please note that this spraying occurs every week, and this notice serves as your notice for the season.

Spraying in turf typically takes place in the Spring. You can expect to see an email notification seven days before any visit from the Spray Contractor.

On Friday, April 29th, there will be spraying with a fungicide application at 225 Vista Rim Drive and broadleaf Turf Spray on May 2nd in Forest Greens.
