FLAG ETIQUETTE REMINDER – Homeowners, please take a minute to review a few American flag etiquette guidelines:

- The flag should not be displayed on days when the weather is inclement, except when an all-weather flag is displayed
- The custom is to display the flag only from sunrise to sunset on flagstaffs in the open, but it may be displayed at night if illuminated
- When a flag is so tattered that it can no longer serve as a symbol of the United States, it should be destroyed in a dignified manner, preferably by burning – contact your local American Legion for dignified and fire-safe flag disposal
