

Community Wildfire Protection — Pending Operations.

This is a follow-up to our 27 February e-blast. Your Community Wildfire Protection Committee (CWP) wants to update you on two pending Contractor supported wildfire protection activities planned for the week of 27-31 March 2023. The two separate tasks are:

Monday (27th). Processing of storm damaged trees on both East and West Ridge areas. Damaged trees will be trimmed and chipped on-site, and pre-staged material piles will also be chipped on-site. Caution advisory for vehicles using Eagle Crest Boulevard and Owners using pathways for recreation.

Tuesday Friday (28th-31 March 2023---extended to 3 April, if required). Completion of previously deferred wildfire protection treatment on the un-irrigated areas of twelve holes on the Ridge golf courses (Four holes on the Challenge(C) and eight holes on the Ridge(R) course, respectively. Specifically:

C1/2/17/18, and R1/2/5/6/7/8/9/14

As was done in February 2022, trees identified for treatment within the un-irrigated areas were re-surveyed and validated in late February 2023. All trees will be trimmed/limbed. Those trees designated for thinning are marked with lime green; orange tape denotes boundaries for reference. Within the un-irrigated areas, grass and brush concentrations will also be treated. Wood boles produced will be collected and staged for Third Party removal.
