**Nutcracker Gate** – The traffic gate at the intersection of Nutcracker Dr. and Cline Falls Highway is now in full operation for the season. To enter the property from the Highway you will have to use your remote control to open the gate. The gate will open automatically to exit.

# READY FOR FIRE SEASON?

## RECOA FIREFREE EVENT APRIL 22 THRU MAY 9

- Concentrate on preparing your ***Home Ignition Zone (HIZ)*** (30 Feet from the home structure)--see guidelines on the RECOA website under CWP Committee.
- Pile flammable yard debris on the edge of the road next to your property beginning April 22<sup>nd</sup>, **OR help by delivering bags beginning May 2<sup>nd</sup> to dumpster sites at Cinnamon Teal/Merlin or Oxbow Loop near the Equestrian Center.**
- Flammable debris includes evergreen limbs, sage, rabbit brush, bitter brush, pine needles, dry leaves, and long, dry grasses. Smaller plant debris should be put in heavy duty paper landscape bags.
- **Cut limbs or small trees into sections no longer than 4 feet.**
- **Please wait until April 22<sup>nd</sup> to put debris out along the street.**
- ***No root balls, grass clippings, plastic bags, rocks, household trash, sod, potting soil or yucca plants will be picked up!!***
