### Message from our Community Wildfire Protection Committee - Program update

Starting the week of 15 May, we will be initiating a 13 day wildfire protection treatment effort focusing on Grass-Brush Management. The work will conclude on/about 2 June. This prescribed treatment activity will be conducted with Contractor resources with CWP oversight and will focus predominantly on the West Ridge Common Areas and our primary Evacuation/Access routes. As before, this effort will entail trimming/pruning of branches, trimming brush and grasses under tree canopies, breaking the continuity on brush clusters, and mowing where the terrain is suitable. Currently, we do not plan to thin/remove trees unless we encounter a hazardous or diseased tree. In some of the areas to be treated, you will see ORANGE marking tape. *We use Orange to denote boundaries in the areas to be treated*.

PLEASE NOTE: We are clearly aware and sensitive to the fact that we will be working in areas that can support habitat. As before, we actively scan for the presence of nesting and avoid these areas if encountered.

Areas of planned coverage: We will be working the Common Areas along the William Lyche Corridor and along Eagle Crest Boulevard. The Common Areas between Vista Rim and Highland Parks and between Highland Meadow Loop and Vista Rim/Highland Parks, and the Common Areas at Vireo Court will be active.

# PLEASE NOTE: Our contractor will be using the Pathways and/or roadsides for mobility and access so please, be aware and take caution when you are near these areas.

In addition, we plan to apply Grass-Brush treatment to some of the un-irrigated areas of the Ridge Golf course. This will entail mowing and trimming/pruning where necessary. Where necessary, we will use the Orange marking tape to define property areas and the treatment area. NOTE: We are not constrained by the White stakes that are the established Golf Course Out-Of-Bounds markers.
